Under 17's Nationals - 2nd October.

Wales' best U17's to the court to battle hard for the title of U17 National Champion. Hosted in Sport Wales Nation Centre. Whose staff had made the venue look impeccable, this was a keenly contested event with some excellent displays on show.

Badminton Wales' Performance Players, Harper Leigh and Saffron Morris both showed their dominance in taking multiple titles with Harper taking all three and Saffron taking two. Although such was her level it would have been hard to bet against her in the Girl Single's Doubles should she have played. The only downside to the event was the cancellation of the WD event due to a lack of entries.

Boys Singles

Harper Leigh showed what he has been in multiple European Finals this year with a dominant display. However, the final proved a high quality affair and Harper was made to work for his title with a strong display from Gwent Youth County BC player, Llwyd Crump. The final went Harper's way with a scoreline of 21-12 21-19

Harper and Crump then teamed up to form a formidable pair and they took the Boy's Double title. However, Amay Patil and Faaris Ahmad played exceptionally well and were fully deserved their Silver medals with some excellent play.



Girl's singles saw Saffron Morris again show her superb skills in taking the Singles title with a composed showing against future starlet Isha Mekala. Saffron won the title after a score of 21-17 21-13



The Mixed Doubles saw a great battle between Harper and Saffron playing against Llwyd Crump and Bhavana Bale. After a long day's play these four wonderful athletes played a great match which Harper and Saffron came out on top with a score of 21-19 21-20
