
By donating to The Racket Room, you will be;

ASPIRE

Badminton Wales is passionate about helping the next generation of badminton coach/enthusiast create our future and ensure Welsh badminton success.

Aspire is a Mentoring and Training programme designed for young badminton enthusiasts who will become an integral part of the future of Welsh badminton. Currently being developed with 5 volunteers Aspire is now being rolled out formally in Autumn/Winter 2023.

Aspire is looking to help young individuals (16-20) start their journey to be the next generation of badminton coach/club member/volunteer. Aspire is, initially, designed for young badminton enthusiasts who will gain experience in Technical Coaching plus Club and Event development. Aspire will provide you with hands-on coaching experience under the guidance of a BW Performance coach. Aspire candidates will also form part of a Youth Council – giving a voice to the future generations of young badminton player.

To complete the course participants will be required to collect all certificates plus log a minimum of 40 coaching hours (at National Junior Squad sessions) and a further 40 volunteering hours in event delivery, officialdom, management and digital strategies etc.

2024 Prohibited List and Tramadol Ban

You may have recently seen that the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has published the 2024 Prohibited List and a summary of key changes, found here.

A key change this year is that from 1 January 2024, **tramadol** will be prohibited in-competition. Any athlete found to be using tramadol incompetition faces the prospect of an Anti-Doping Rule Violation and a ban from sport.
